


## Stage# 1



### Stage Description: Zom-Bees

- Location: SLSC Pistol-Pits, Bay #1
- Targets (Type & Number):
  - 2 large rectangles, 2-3 large discs, stop-plate is small disk for rifle, large-disk for pistol
- Procedure for CoF:
  - 2 rounds each P1 & P3, 1 round each P2 & P4 (and P5 for rifle), in any order
  - 1 round to P5 stopper for pistol, +1 round for P6 stopper for pistol
- Minimum Number of Rounds Needed: 7 rounds per run for pistol / 8 for rifle
- Scoring Method: Actual Time + Penalties
- Stop-Signal: Last Shot Fired
- Penalties:
  - +2 seconds per missed plate / 30 seconds for missed stop-plate
- Number of Strings to be Fired: 5 total, worst score is dropped
- Start Position:
  - Handgun: Shoot box @ 15 yards / Rifle: Shoot box @ 20 yards
- Firearm Ready Conditions
  - Handgun / Rifle: Firearm mounted and aimed at cone, round-Chambered, Safety-Off, Finger outside trigger-guard
- Time Starts: Audible Tone

## Stage# 2




### Stage Description: Zig-Zag II

- Location: SLSC Pistol-Pits, Bay #2
- Targets (Type & Number):
  - 7 large discs, +1 small disk for rifle
- Procedure for CoF:
  - 1 round each, in sequential order
- Minimum Number of Rounds Needed: 7 rounds per run for pistol / 8 for rifle
- Scoring Method: Actual Time + Penalties
- Stop-Signal: Last Shot Fired
- Penalties:
  - +2 seconds per missed plate / 30 seconds for missed stop-plate
- Number of Strings to be Fired: 5 total, worst score is dropped
- Start Position:
  - Handgun: Shoot box @ 15 yards from stopper / Rifle: Shoot box @ 20 yards
- Firearm Ready Conditions
  - Handgun / Rifle: Low-Ready, with elbows at sides, Round-Chambered, Safety-Off, Finger outside trigger-guard
- Time Starts: Audible Tone

# SLSC RF Steel Match RF Plate Rack



## Stage Description

- Location: SLSC Pistol-Pits
- Targets (Type & Number):
  - 5 mini-IDPA silhouettes on rimfire target rack
- Procedure for CoF: 1 round each, P1-P5, last plate up is stopper
- Minimum Number of Rounds Needed: 5 (plates must drop to be counted)
- Scoring Method: Actual Time + Penalties
- Stop-Signal: Last Shot Fired
- Penalties:
  - +2 seconds per missed plate
  - 30 seconds for missed stop-plate
- Number of Strings to be Fired: 5 total, worst score is dropped
- Start Position:
  - Handgun: Shoot box @ 7 yards / Rifle: Shoot box @ 11 yards
- Firearm Ready Conditions:
  - Low-Ready, Elbows at sides, Round-Chambered, Safety-Off, Finger outside trigger-guard
- Time Starts: Audible Tone
